- Appropriate and accurate processing of all paperwork.
- Ensuring vehicle maintenance, including safety checks.
- Follow correct PPE regulations and compliance with infection control processes.
- Participating in the on-call rota (with an enhanced allowance during this period).

- Have a maintenance/mechanical engineering background, preferably with experience of DC electrics although this is not essential.

- Demonstrate empathy and resilience in what can be quite challenging situations.
- Have good communication skills and are well presented.
- Be physically capable due to the nature of the work as it involves lifting heavy wheelchairs

- Be self-motivated and able to work alone.
- Strong knowledge of the local area would be a distinct advantage.
