- Facilitate regular events that will raise the profile of the Somerset Disability Engagement Service, the NHS wheelchair service and AJM Clinical Commercial Services.
- Establish and maintain co-working relationships, including the attendance at relevant meetings, with key partners and other organisations, to ensure that partners are aware of the services that AJM offer.
- Recruit and support a team of volunteers to conduct access audits in Somerset.
- Facilitate learning events to highlight the importance of accessibility to local organisations including the local business and the retail sector.
- Provide admin support to the wheelchair service user forums.
- Maintain data for contract requirements, monitoring and taking action on over/under performance contract areas.
- Develop partnership working relationships with other professionals working with the disabled community.
- Be an active participant on social media.
